EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31 Series 2021

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (LYOC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BANSUD, ORIENTAL MINDORO, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

WHEREAS, Article 2 Section 13 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that, "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and thus promotes and protects their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being, inculcate in them patriotism, nationalism and other desirable values and encourages their involvement in public and civic affairs";

WHEREAS, SECTION 23 OF THE Republic Act 10742 otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 provides that to ensure wide and multi-sectoral youth participation in local governance there shall be in every province, city and municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) mandated to assist in the planning and execution of programs and projects of the Sangguniang Kabataan and the Pederasyons in all levels;

WHEREAS, the LYDC shall serve as the main advocate for youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment, monitoring and implementation of programs and projects embodied in the Local Youth Development Plan;

WHEREAS, Section 24 (i) Rule III of the Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 10742 states that the LYDC shall composed of at least ten (10) but not more than twenty one (21) members including the two (2) core member from the Sangguniang Kabataan. The two (2) core member shall be composed of the president and the vice-president of the concerned Pederasyon and shall be supported by at least eight (8) but not more than nineteen (19) other representations from registered youth organizations or youth-serving organizations provided that all other incumbent SK Officials shall not be eligible as member of the LYDC.

NOW THEREFORE, I, RONALDO M. MORADA, Municipal Mayor of Bansud Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the Creation of the Local Youth Development Council of the Municipality of Bansud.

SECTION 1. CREATION OF LYDC -The Local Youth Development Council of the municipality of Bansud is hereby created.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION -The LYDC shall be composed of the following

- a. Chairperson- Bansud SK Pederasyon President
- b. Vice Chairman- Bansud SK Pederasyon Vice President
- c. Member/s :

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS -The LYDC shall have the following functions;

1. Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment;
2. Finalize the three (3) years LYDC that is anchored in the PYDP and the development plans of the local government units;
The LYDP shall be initially drafted by the respective SK Pederasyon and shall be finalized by the LYDC. This shall be submitted to the LCE for inclusion in the local development plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sanggunian of the local government unit concerned for approval. These plans shall give priority to programs, projects and activities that will promote and ensure the meaningful youth participation in nation-building, sustainable youth development and empowerment , equitable access to quality education , environmental protection, climate change adaptation ,disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth empowerment and livelihood, health and anti – drug abuse, gender sensitivity, social protection, capability building and sports development;
3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the LYDP;
4. Coordinate with the National Youth Council (NYC) and other agencies to achieve effectively the objectives and attain the goals of the LYDP;
5. Perform such other functions as may be presented by law or ordinance.

SECTION 4. CONVENING OF THE LYDC -The LYDC shall schedule a meeting every quarter, or as often as needed.

SECTION 5. SECRETARIAT -The local youth development officer (LYDO) shall serve as secretariat to the LYDC, Accordingly, the LYDO shall assist in the conduct of meetings, take charge of communications and notices, prepare reports and take custody of all records, data, information and documents of the LYDC.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY -This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
