RESOLUTION NO. 149 S. 2020

SANGGUNIANG BAYAN RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FY 2020 GENERAL FUND, REVERSION OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND (P1,900,000.00) PESOS FROM MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES (MOOE) AND REALIGNMENT OF UNEXPENDED ALLOCATION FOR MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS AND TRUST FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN MILLION EIGHTY SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY TWO (P7,087,252.00) PESOS TO AUGMENT THE DISASTER RESPONSE REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY PROGRAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY AMIDST CORONAVIRUS 2019 (COVID-19) PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the R. A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides, and it reads, "Local Government Units (LGUs) shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, in an effort to rally the national resources and energy to control the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in the country which is now a global concern, President Rodrigo R. Duterte has issued Proclamation No. 929 S. 2020, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines for a period of Six (6) months, and enjoined all government agencies and local government units (LGUs) to render full assistance to and cooperation with each other and mobilize necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, considering the general welfare of all Basudeños, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) has convened on March 23, 2020, wherein they identified different programs and activities necessary for the implementation of preventive and protective measures in limiting and eradicating the danger of COVID-19 and passed a resolution pertaining thereto;

WHEREAS, likewise, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) has conducted a Special Meeting on March 24, 2020, and approved Supplemental Annual Investment Plan (SAIP) for CY 2020 of the municipality, containing the entire service requirements and expenditures on programs and activities in which both councils has identified and prioritized with a total investment amounting to Eighteen Million One Hundred Thousand (P18, 100,000.00) Pesos as embodied in MDC Resolution No. 2020-01;

WHEREAS, currently, the municipal government of Bansud has an available fund in the amount of Eight Million Nine Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Two (8,987,352.00) Pesos taken from Travelling and Training Funds of the FY 2020 Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Continuing appropriations and Trust Fund of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) based on local budget spelled out hereto which can be appropriated to finance urgent programs, projects and activities related with the local COVID-19 control measures;



WHEREAS, the appropriation for Crisis Intervention Assistance and Disaster Response Rehabilitation and Recovery have been proposed pursuant to Presidential Proclamation Nos. 922 and 929 and Republic Act No. 11332 or the "Act Providing Policies and Prescribing Procedures on Surveillance and Response to Notifiable Diseases, Epidemics and Health Events of Public Concern and Appropriating Funds Therefor",

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 47 stated that, "An ordinance providing for a supplemental budget may also be enacted in times of public calamity by way of budgetary realignment to set aside appropriations for the purchase of supplies and materials or the payment of services, which are exceptionally urgent or absolutely indispensable to prevent imminent danger to, or loss of, life and property, in the jurisdiction of the local government unit or in other areas declared in an state of calamity by the President. Such ordinance shall clearly indicate the sources of funds available for appropriations, as certified under oath jointly by the local treasurer and the local accountant and attested by the local chief executive, and various items of appropriations affected, and the reasons for the changes";

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as it is hereby ordained, to enact the General Fund Reversion of Funds for Fiscal year 2020 of the Municipality of Bansud, Oriental Mindoro, stated below as follows:

Section 1. Revenue Sources. The revenue sources as certified by the Municipal Treasurer and Municipal Accountant per Local Budget Preparation Form No. 8 shall be taken from the following, to wit:

1. Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) - P 1, 900,000.00




Section 3. Appropriations for Crisis Intervention Assistance. Appropriations for the crisis intervention assistance pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 929 dated 16 March 2020 and R.A. 11332, is hereby proposed.

Section 4. Appropriations for Disaster Response, rehabilitation and recovery. Appropriations for the disaster response, rehabilitation and recovery pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 929 dated 16 March 2020 and R.A. 11332, is hereby proposed.

Section 5. Reversion/realignment of Fund. Some programs and projects' appropriations were proposed to be reverted/realigned to fund other urgent programs, projects and activities relative to curtailing and eliminating the threat of COVID-19;

Section 6. Liability of Department Head. The Department Head concerned shall refund to the Municipal Government any expenditures incurred in excess of the allocation for each item intended for his department;



Section 7. Compliance with Relevant Law. All existing laws, rules and regulations, such as the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, as well as those that may be properly complied with in the implementation of this Ordinance.

Section 8. Separability Clause. If for any reason any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, other sections or provisions which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect;

Section 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval hereof in accordance with Section 320 of R.A. 7160.


